## **Statement on EU Biocidal Products Regulation**

The EU Biocidal Products Regulation (BPR, Regulation (EU) 528/2012) ensures the safe use of biocidal products by regulating their market placement and use, protecting human health and the environment, and ensuring product efficacy.

Under Article 2(1), the regulation applies to biocidal products and treated articles. Article 3(1)(a) defines a biocidal product as a substance or mixture intended to control harmful organisms through chemical or biological means, excluding purely physical or mechanical actions. Article 3(1)(I) defines a treated article as any substance, mixture, or article that has been treated with or intentionally incorporates one or more biocidal products.

Since Nexperia's semiconductor products do not contain substances or mixtures intended to control harmful organisms, they fall outside the scope of the regulation.

The signature below confirms that the statements above, including but not limited to product composition data, are valid and accurate to the best of our knowledge. Nexperia has implemented robust compliance systems to ensure our products meet global environmental regulations and legal requirements. However, not all materials in Nexperia's products may have been independently verified for substance content.
