

Statement on California Proposition 65

California Proposition 65, also known as the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, aims to protect drinking water sources from chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm and to inform the public about potential exposures to such substances.

Nexperia continuously monitors and reviews the California Proposition 65 substance list to ensure compliance. Following a reassessment of supplier certifications and material composition declarations, Nexperia has determined, to the best of its knowledge and belief, that its products:

- May contain substances listed under California Proposition 65. Information on specific substances can be found in Nexperia's product composition declarations.
